The scholarship is applicable only to fall and spring semesters and covers up to \$3,150 per semester. A Jacksonville College representative will present the scholarship annually at the SOAR Conference to a recipient whose name is drawn randomly from those students who indicate at the SOAR Conference an interest in attending Jacksonville College.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be a U.S. citizen or have been a resident for three years and in the process of filing for citizenship.
2. Must make application to Jacksonville College.
3. Must successfully complete the FAFSA or TASFA.
4. Must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA which will be checked at the end of the academic year. Courses taken in summer school count toward the cumulative GPA.
5. Must attend all regularly scheduled chapel meetings.
6. Must abide by the rules and guidelines set by the Administration of Jacksonville College and maintain high moral standards.
7. Must enroll for and maintain at least 15 semester hours of associate-degree courses each semester.
8. Class attendance is required.
9. Must write a letter of appreciation to the Jacksonville College Administration.
10. If the recipient's date of degree conferment occurs in May, the recipient is expected to participate in the spring graduation ceremony.
